

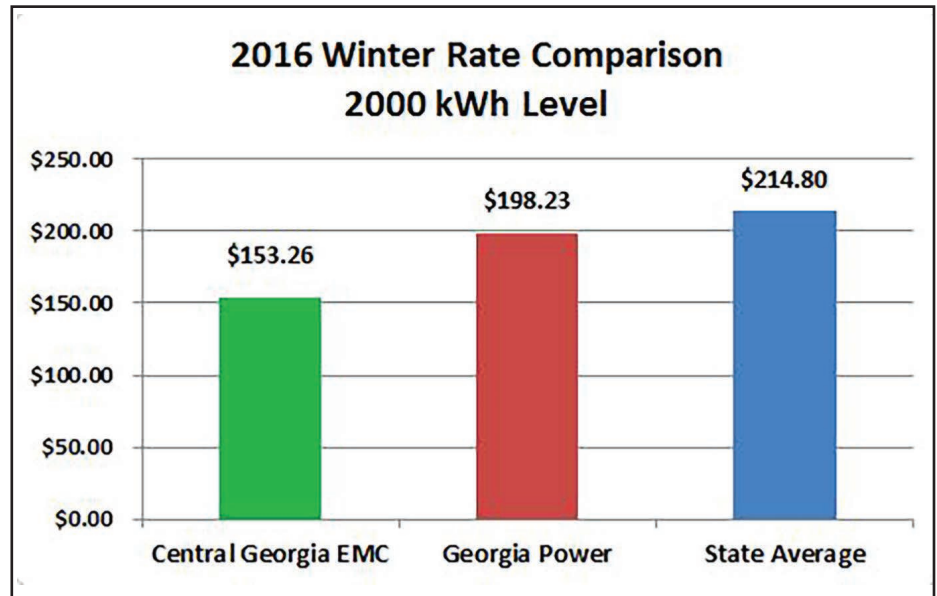


## Central Georgia EMC Ranks Among the Lowest-Cost Electric Providers in Georgia

The Georgia Public Service Commission recently released its 2016 Winter Residential Rate Survey. The survey ranks each of the 94 electric providers in Georgia by each utility's residential electric rates, based on 2,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh), 1,500 kWh, 1,000 kWh, and 500 kWh of usage.

Central Georgia EMC (CGEMC) ranked as the second-lowest cost electric provider at the 2,000 kWh and 1,500 kWh levels. CGEMC ranked fifth lowest at the 1,000 kWh level.

"One of the core principles of Central Georgia EMC is to provide our members with low-cost, reliable electric service," says President George L. Weaver. "We remain one of the lowest-cost providers in the state of Georgia. Our members benefit from our diligence to uphold our principles and ensure the highest level of service at affordable rates."

Are you constantly on the go? Juggling home, work, and family? Central Georgia EMC (CGEMC) understands your busy schedule. For added convenience, CGEMC's Customer Portal is now offering several payment options:

### Future Payments

The future payment option allows you to set up a one-time credit card or e-check payment for a future date. Log in to the Customer Portal at [www.cgemc.com](http://www.cgemc.com), choose the Schedule Future Payment option from the payment menu; enter your credit card or checking information, the payment date, and the amount to pay. Your payment will process on the date you choose, and you will receive a confirmation email when your payment has posted.

**Auto-Pay by E-Check**

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### Automatic Payments

The automatic payment option also allows you to set up recurring monthly payments using a credit card or checking account. Log in to the Customer Portal at [www.cgemc.com](http://www.cgemc.com), choose the Schedule Automatic Payment option from the payment menu, and enter either your credit card or checking information. Elect to pay on your due date, or select another time, and your payment will process automatically each month. You will receive a confirmation email when your payment posts.

The flexibility of scheduling your payments allows you to use the automatic payment system for all future payments, or for a particular period. By choosing an end date, your payments will no longer process after that date. You can update your settings as your needs change.

For prepaid customers, automatic payments are an excellent option. You can set up your payment to process when your account reaches a certain balance. You choose the balance threshold and the payment amount, and your payment will automatically process each time your balance drops below the amount you specified.

To access these options, please visit [www.cgemc.com](http://www.cgemc.com), choose the Customer Portal link and sign in to your account. While you are there, sign up for E-Bill. With E-Bill, you get the same detail available to you on the paper bill that you receive each month, without the hassle of paper. We will send you an email when your bill is ready to view.

## Recipe of the Month



### Spicy Meatloaf

#### Ingredients:

1 1/2 pounds ground beef (85% lean)  
1 large egg  
1/2 cup chopped onion  
1 sleeve of butter crackers, crumbled  
1 can Mexican-style tomatoes,  
undrained  
1/2 cup ketchup  
1 packet of Tex-Mex dry chili  
seasoning mix  
Salt, pepper, and garlic powder to taste

#### Directions:

Mix above ingredients well and place in a greased glass (or metal) loaf pan. Top with a mixture of 1/2 cup ketchup and Tex-Mex dry chili seasoning mix (use about 1/4 packet, or to taste). Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour and 15 minutes, or until internal temperature reaches 160 degrees.
