<p>How will my bill be calculated?</p>	<p>All Central Georgia EMC members are eligible to purchase Green Power from Central Georgia EMC on a “first come, first served” basis. Central Georgia EMC’s Green Power is available to members in blocks of 150 kWh for an additional fee of \$ 4.50 each month.</p>						
<p>How much will my total electricity service cost, including utility charges?</p>	<p>Based on a monthly average usage of 500 kWh and the purchase of one, 150 kWh Green Power block, the following table provides you an estimate of your 2020 monthly electricity bill. For comparison, the 2019 average mix of resources supplying Central Georgia EMC includes: Coal (6.36%), Nuclear (20.24%), Oil (0%), Natural Gas (69.88%), Hydroelectric (3.29%), Solar (.11%) and Other (.11%).
