



2019 EXISTING HOME REBATES

Homeowners can save energy while improving their home's comfort level by adopting energy-efficient practices. Substantial savings are possible by updating some features to improve your home's efficiency.

Air-Source Heat Pump

Electric air-source heat pumps use the difference between outdoor air temperatures and indoor air temperatures to cool and heat your home. Energy Star qualified heat pumps have a higher Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) and an energy efficiency ratio (EER) than standard models. Air-source heat pumps are 9% more efficient than standard new models and 20% more efficient than what you may have in your home.

- Conversion from gas to total electric air-source heat pump,
 - 16 SEER or greater, \$400
 - less than 16 SEER, \$250
- Replacement of an existing electric system with total electric air-source heat pump or VRF conversion/add-on,
 - 16 SEER or greater, \$400



Water Heaters

The water heater is the second largest energy user in a home. Electric water heaters are economical and efficient. They are simple and convenient with low standby heat loss. The average U.S. household spends between \$400 and \$600 per year to heat water for showers, dishwashing, and other daily activities.

- Gas to electric storage water heater,
 - 40 gallon or larger, \$150
- Replacement of existing electric storage water heater,
 - 40 gallon or larger, \$100



Equipment must be installed on or after January 1, 2019, to qualify for the rebate. Customer must consent to have a load management switch installed on qualifying equipment before the rebate can be processed. The load management switch must remain on equipment and in operating status as long as CGEMC has a Load Management Program.
