Job Description

JOB TITLE: Senior Vice President of Energy Supply

SUMMARY: Provides executive leadership for CGEMC's energy supply, resource planning, wholesale contracting, risk management, and large-load strategy. Oversees day-to-day operations and regulatory compliance of CGEMC's natural gas marketer subsidiary.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following (other duties may be assigned):

Directs long-term energy supply and resource planning activities

Manages wholesale power and fuel supply contracts and supplier relationships

Leads load forecasting, modeling, and budgeting efforts for wholesale energy transactions

Responsible for cost-of-service studies and rate tariff recommendations

Manages energy supply risk, hedging strategies, and cost control initiatives

Coordinates closely with operations, transmission, and system planning

Leads large-load and data center program strategy and member engagement

Represents CGEMC in regulatory, market, and supplier engagements

Supports corporate strategy and business development

Coordinates natural gas marketer agent activities

Participates in a supervisory on-call rotation

Performs other functions and responsibilities as assigned

Is aware of and complies with Corporation policy on Affirmative Action, Equal Employment Opportunity, and non-discrimination of customers on any benefits offered by the CGEMC.

Complies with CGEMC's safety rules and regulations while performing duties.

Complies with OSHA rules and regulations.

SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITIES: Carries out supervisor responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws. Responsibilities include interviewing, hiring, and training employees; planning, assigning, and directing work; appraising performance; rewarding and disciplining employees; addressing complaints; and resolving problems.

DIRECTS: Manager of Energy Supply Operations and Planning

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE:

A bachelor's degree in Engineering, Economics, Finance, Energy Management, Business Administration, or a related field is required; an MBA or other relevant master's degree is preferred. This position requires a minimum of 15 years of experience in energy supply, power markets, or utility planning. At least 8 years of leadership experience is required, including responsibility for wholesale contracting and resource planning, as well as experience leading, supervising, or directing the work of others.

LANGUAGE SKILLS:

Ability to read, analyze, and interpret technical, financial, and regulatory documents. Ability to write reports and business correspondence and effectively present information to management, regulators, and stakeholders.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS:

Ability to work with advanced mathematical concepts including statistics, forecasting, financial modeling, and cost-of-service analysis.

REASONING ABILITY:

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form. Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts, and draw valid conclusions involving complex variables.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS:

Valid Georgia driver's license. Georgia ITS 5-Day Certification. Professional certifications as applicable.

OTHER SKILLS and ABILITIES:

Strong leadership, analytical, communication, and cross-functional coordination skills.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is required to stand, walk, stoop, kneel, crouch, and manipulate (lift, carry, move) light to medium weights of 10-50 pounds. Requires good hand-eye coordination, arm, hand, and finger dexterity, including the ability to grasp, and visual acuity to use a keyboard, operate equipment and read information. The employee is required to sit, reach with hands and arms, talk, and hear.

WORK ENVIRONMENT: The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee regularly works in inside-office conditions.

The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.

Will be randomly tested for drugs and alcohol.

Must be willing to work after hours in emergency situations or as required. Must live in vicinity acceptable to CGEMC. Must be accessible via prompt communication methods such as phone, text, and email.
